**RCTP Grant Resolution- A motion was made to pass a resolution by Jamison and seconded by Regan, all ayes motion passed to apply for the grant.**

**Water report- Stephanie Verjinski was present. She is now a Certified level one operator. Williams reported there is a pole in the park that needs looked at. He also reported a citizen wants to cut the curb for a driveway. The city gave the ok.**

**Regan voiced concerns about speeders in town. He will contact the sheriff department.**

**Witt cut down trees by the lagoon. Witt will flush hydrants every other month.**
